Fees and Payment:

Fees have to be paid in full in our bank account before 5 June. **No cash** will be received at the Consultation.

Staying guests:

R1,000.00 per person. This is from Tuesday morning to Thursday afternoon and includes:

- Accommodation Tuesday and Wednesday night;
- Breakfast, lunch and supper (dinner) on Tuesday and Wednesday; and
- Breakfast and lunch on Thursday.

Additional accommodation:

Monday or Thursday night:
R120 pp per night.



Meals:

- Day visitors requiring evening dinner R55 pp per day.
- Staying guests requiring Monday / Thursday dinner or breakfast on Friday: R55 pp per meal.

Extras must be indicated clearly on the registration form and be paid for in advance together with the registration fee.

Shuttle Service:

We can book a shuttle at an additional fee for those who arrive from far. If you wish to make use of this, make sure that you complete the additional form for this and include the non-refundable fee with your payment.



- Between OR Tambo airport or Johannesburg Park station (bus station) and the venue: R250 pp one way.
- Between Pretoria bus station and the venue: R120 per person one way.
- An additional R100 is charged when people arrive or depart between 19:00 and 06:00.

Please note: We cannot book a shuttle without complete details provided by you and payment received.



Additional Information:

- International participants are responsible for all their travelling documents, the required vaccinations and sufficient cash on hand to ensure entrance into South Africa.
- Travelling costs are each participant's own responsibility and we are not able to assist you with booking your return trip.
- Attendees should remember that this event will be held in winter! Make sure you are warm enough and have medication for potential colds and flues.
- Bible Colleges as well as Theological Seminaries and Institutions are welcome to request a table to display their resources. Please indicate such a request on your registration form. As we can only accommodate a limited number, it will be confirmed in advance whether your request is granted.
- There will be time on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon for 3-5 minute introductory presentations of the different ministries so that we can pray faithfully for each other's work. Please come prepared to share with us what the Lord is doing through your ministry, should your organisation be given a slot.
