### Bible College Consultation - 20 to 22 June 2017

We wish to heartily invite you to the Bible College Consultation hosted by Mukhanyo Theological College.

The theme for this year's consultation is:

### **Christian Ethics for Bible Education in Africa**

This annual event is meant for leaders and lecturers of Bible Schools, Bible Colleges, theological seminaries and related institutions. We wish to bring people from different evangelical organisations and denominations together to reflect on theological education in the day we are living – and especially around this year's theme. All people involved in any form of Bible training are welcome to attend. Please forward this invitation to other people who may be interested.

**Starting: Tuesday 20 June at 08:00**  
**Closing: Thursday 22 June at 17:00**

Those who travel from far are welcome to stay over on Monday as well as Thursday evening for the extra fee indicated. We must vacate the premises on Friday morning at 8:00.

#### **Where:**

**Word in Action Conference Site**  
Sysie Street, Kameeldrift East, Pretoria.

About 60 km from OR Tambo Airport and 15 km from Pretoria CBD.

There is sufficient space to relax, enjoy fellowship or take a walk to the Moreleta brook which borders the property.

#### **Fees and Payment:**

**Staying guests:** R920.00 per person This is from Tuesday morning to Thursday afternoon and includes:

- Accommodation for Tuesday night and Wednesday night;
- Breakfast, lunch and supper (dinner) on Tuesday and Wednesday; and
- Breakfast and lunch on Thursday.

**Day visitors:** R110 per person per day. This includes lunch and tea time refreshments during that day.

#### **Directions from Pretoria:**

- Take the N1 towards Pietersburg/Polokwane up to the Sefako Makgatho (former Zambezi) off ramp.
- Turn right onto the R513 towards Cullinan.
- Proceed for about 2 km, passing the KwaMhlanga road and a shopping centre with garage on the left.
- Turn left at the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of traffic lights towards Kameeldrift. (There is a big white cross on your right.)
- Proceed for about 1.4 km, pass *Die Poort Primary School* on your left hand side and turn left into Sysie Street (immediately after the School).
- Proceed for about 1 km and enter the gates of *Word in Action*.
- Keep straight to the main hall.

### **Extras:**

**Additional accommodation:** Monday or Thursday night: R100 pp per night.

**Meals:** Day visitors requiring dinner R50 pp per day.

Staying guests requiring Monday / Thursday dinner or breakfast on Friday: R50 pp per meal.

Extras must be indicated clearly on the registration form and be paid for in advance together with the registration fee.

### **Shuttle Service:**

We can book a shuttle at an additional fee for those who arrive from far. If you wish to make use of this, make sure that you complete the additional form for this and include the non-refundable fee with your payment.

- Between OR Tambo airport or Johannesburg bus station and the venue: R300 pp one way.
- Between Pretoria bus station and the venue: R120 per person one way.

**Please note:** We cannot book a shuttle without complete details provided by you and payment.

### **Additional Information:**

1. International participants are responsible for all their travelling documents, the required vaccinations and sufficient cash on hand (R3,000) to ensure entrance into South Africa.
2. Travelling costs are each participant's own responsibility and we are not able to assist you with booking your return trip.
3. Attendees should remember that this event will be held in winter! Make sure you are warm enough and have medication for potential colds and flues.
4. Bible Colleges as well as Theological Seminaries and Institutions are welcome to request a table to display their resources. Please indicate such a request on your registration form. As we can only accommodate a limited number, it will be confirmed in advance whether your request is granted.
5. There will be time on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon for 3-5 minute introductory presentations of the different ministries so that we can pray faithfully for each other's work. Please come prepared to share with us what the Lord is doing through your ministry, should your organisation be given a slot.
6. **Christian books** will be available for sale by *Grace Media* at the conference. Should you wish to place a specific order, please do not hesitate to contact them prior to the conference.
