Vacancy: Videographer - Full Time

This new position at Mukhanyo requires the right dedicated person, to serve an average of 40 hours per week, and when required in the evenings, based in KwaMhlanga.

Key Roles and Responsibilities:

- Record lectures and other assemblies like the graduation using cameras, and audio equipment supplied by Mukhanyo Theological College.
- Direct lecturers to capture specific action and events for the camera for optimal results.
- Use software to edit captured video to create concise, educational, and visually pleasing lectures.
- Set up and break down recording equipment before and after use, when required.
- Knowledge of cameras and equipment.
- Calibrating and maintaining equipment.
- Troubleshoot problems with equipment and suggesting improvements.
- Working in the studio as part of a production team to edit recordings.
- Inserting closed captioning, graphics, or other on-screen text into a video.
- Adding computer graphics and special effects to a video.
- Do Quality Assurance on edited videos.
- Ensure the studio is managed in a professional way with high regard for the equipment.

General Requirements:

- Manual dexterity, physical mobility, and physical strength/stamina.
- Creativity and attention to detail.
- Ability to work under deadline pressure.
- Manage time efficiently.
- Flexibility and good listening skills
- Energy and determination.

- Technical acumen to be able to operate, configure, set up, and fix video, audio, lighting, or other production equipment.
