- Be an ordained minister in a church or denomination that subscribes to the Three Forms of Unity, the Westminster Confession of Faith, and/or the London Baptist Confession of Faith 1689.
- Feel called by God to serve on Mukhanyo team for the coming of Christ's kingdom.
- Demonstrate excellent administrative, research, interpersonal, conflict resolution, and communication skills with the ability to provide godly mentoring within a multicultural institution.
