Mr Basilius Kasera (BTS, PGDipTE, and MTh) joined the *Namibia Evangelical Theological (NETS)* in 2010, served as the Academic Dean (2012-2015) and lecturer of Systematic Theology and Contextual Theology. Besides teaching theology, he serves as council member on the *National Council for Higher Education*, theological advisor and speaker for the *Southern African Christian Initiative*, and as a part-time lecturer of philosophy and applied ethics at the *University of Namibia*. He is married to Justene and they have two children, Abigail and Austin.



Dr David Beakley found Christ in 1997, and entered training for the ministry in January 2000. After being trained at the Masters Seminary in LA (MDiv), he was called to be a lecturer at *Christ Seminary* (Polokwane), teaching Hermeneutics, Greek, Hebrew and Expository Preaching. He currently also serves as Academic Dean there. In 2014, he completed his PhD in Old Testament Theology from the *Northwest University* and since 2015 has been the Senior Pastor of Baptist Church in Polokwane. David is married to Carol (34 years), and they are blessed with four children that all live in the USA.



Rev John Child lectures in Theology and ethics at *George Whitefield College (GWC)*, Muizenberg, Cape Town, where he has taught for 20 years. Previously he was the Rector of *Christ Church*, Umhlanga, and spent 13 years in business in Johannesburg. While at GWC he intentionally planted *Muizenburg Community Church* as a multi ethnic church, embracing both African and Western styles of worship. Dr de Vries is presently leading his third church plant in South Africa and also serves as senior lecturer on the faculty of theology at North West University and visiting professor at *Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary* in the United States.



Rev Jim Wright lectures New Testament and Biblical Languages at *John Wycliffe Theological College* in Johannesburg where he is also the Academic Dean. He has a Diploma in Theology from *Bible Institute of Southern Africa*, a B.A. from the *University of South Africa*, and a M.A.R. from *Westminster Theological Seminary*. He lectured in a missions training college in the UK for 6 years before returning to Pietermaritzburg to teach in a seminary for 13 years. From 2005, he worked for *Overseas Council International* for 6 years visiting 40 evangelical seminaries in 23 African countries. He retired in 2010, but still teach on a D Min programme in Nairobi. Last year he went to South Sudan as a consultant to the African Inland Church. He is currently a 'Scholar care Giver' of African students doing doctorates in South Africa who are on John Stott scholarships.
